

4.2 - CIVIL EMERGENCY NOTICES

FIRE

STOP THINK ACT

GENERAL FIRE

- Raise the alarm
- Call the Fire Brigade 111
- Call your manager
- Do not endanger yourself
- Make sure you have an escape route
- Do not use water on petroleum or electrical fires
- Do not leave the site unattended
- Shut down plant & machinery
- Switch off Electrical Mains Power supply

SMALL FIRE

- Use Fire Extinguisher
- Contain & extinguish fire if safe to do so

LARGE FIRE

- Do not attempt to extinguish fire
- Retreat to a safe distance
- Ensure someone can direct Emergency services to the scene

STOP THINK ACT

CIVIL EMERGENCY

You could be on your own for 3 days

Listen to the radio for advice & information

Do not use the telephone unless you need urgent help

Dial 111 for Emergency Services

EARTHQUAKE

- Stay indoors
- **DROP, COVER & HOLD**
- Take cover under a sturdy table or next to an exterior wall
- Protect property
- If driving pull over to the side of the road & remain in the vehicle
- Treat injuries
- Turn off heaters & put out fires
- Turn off water & electricity at the mains
- Check your neighbours
- Be prepared for aftershocks

IN A STORM

- Stay indoors
- Close curtains & stay away from doors and windows
- Take shelter
- Avoid driving
- Avoid damaged power lines

IN A FLOOD

- Raise or remove valuables
- Raise or remove weed killers or chemicals
- Locate to the nearest high safe ground
- Listen to the radio and follow Civil Defence instructions
- Avoid flooded areas
- Do not drink floodwater

STOP THINK ACT

IN A TSUNAMI WARNING

- Move inland to high ground
- DO NOT go to the beach, streams and rivers
- Listen to the radio for information and follow Civil Defence instructions

IN AN ERUPTION

- Stay indoors
- Save water
- Keep gutters & roof clear to prevent collapse
- Close windows & doors
- IF YOU HAVE TO GO OUTSIDE:
- Wear substantial clothing & cover your head
- Breathe through a cloth

IF YOU HAVE TO BE EVACUATED TAKE

- Essential items
- Important documents
- Radio & torch
- Bottled water
- Warm clothing

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- Turn off water, electricity & gas at mains
- Lock the property
- Consider your pets
- WHEN YOU REACH SAFETY listen to your radio for further instructions
